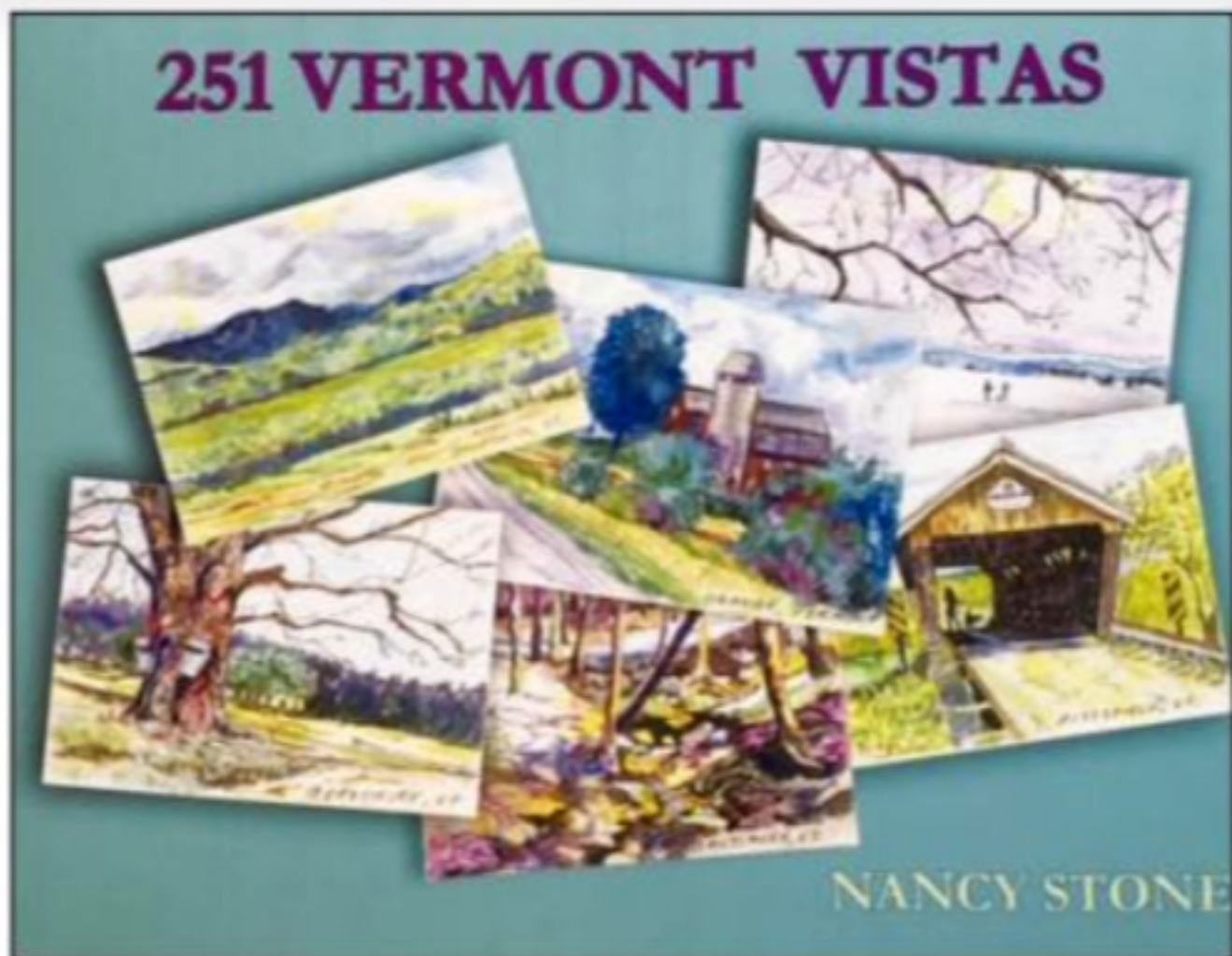


Vermont 251 celebration upcoming

Celebrate Vermont's 251 Club — people who have visited every town in the state — with Williston artist Nancy Stone and filmmaker Mike Leonard next Wednesday in a program sponsored by the Dorothy Alling Memorial Library.

The event will start at 6 p.m. Aug. 21 at the Williston Central School auditorium. Stone's original watercolor postcards, depicting her travels to each of Vermont's 251 towns, will be on display, and Leonard's film, "One Town at a Time," will be shown at 7 p.m. The documentary features interviews from members of the 251 Club highlighting the spirit of each town. A Q&A with Leonard will follow the screening.
